Rick calls the meeting to order.

The minutes for the Regular meeting held February 5th were read by all. John made a motion to approve the minutes. It was second by Paul and was approved by all saying aye.

The January Treasurer's Report was read by all. Paul made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. It was second by John and approved by all saying aye.

John made a motion to accept the bills as presented. Paul second it and it was approved by all saying aye.

Managers Report

All the trees have been cleared and the fence removed along the east side from the south end up to Ivan Baines property. There are still two holes to fill in where there were two burn piles that was dug out, for root balls and such, but has been to muddy to fill in. Talk to Jim Schwerman and he's going to have Jim Hampton come in and run a ripper over it to break it up, to get it ready to farm. Scott said he's still waiting on parts from Hali-Brite to fix the beacon, that it's still out. Reber Welding came out and repaired Steve's hangar door where Tim Swiney, who had just purchased Tyler Chamberlains plane, an Aeronica Champ, came out and tried propping it himself and it got away from him. Scott said Tim grabbed the right wing tip and it spun around running into Steve's hangar door barely missing his plane. Tim's plane will be out of service until he gets a new propeller and motor mount and has the engine check out. Tim's a new hangar renter since the plane was already based here and had a hangar.

Scott said he heard from the mowers and that they do plan on coming back this year to mow the grass strips but not sure when yet. Scott mentioned his son Lyle was out and together they rearranged the SRE building and put the snow plow away for the summer. They got the harrow out getting ready for the grass runways and also got the roller filled with water ready to roll them.

Lake Shelbyville Flying Club had two students solo that day, a father and son, Cory Wells and his son Ethan. Scott said the flying club has been a good thing for the airport so far. Scott mentions a person from Decatur has donated a RV6 Kit to the local EAA chapter and it will be discussed at the chapters monthly meeting the next evening. Scott said with that being said, at present it is on his trailer and will need some place to be stored and put together. A short discussion ensued on the matter.

Scott mentions the only thing left with the fence removal is the three gates and what to do with them. After some discussion it was decided that they be removed and possibly replaced with new gates, depending how the fence issue finalizes. Some discussion followed on the subject.

Scott also mentions the CAP folded, (Civil Air Patrol). They had two kids that aged out and didn't have enough to keep the club going. The EAA Chapter 814 here at the airport is having a breakfast/fly-in on May 4th and Scott ask John what his plans for a car show were for this year and John replied that he was thinking on it. Scott also mentioned that he had been contacted by the Covier people again and that they would like

to come back again either late May or early June in 2025. Some discussion on the Covier group ensued. Also the EAA chapter is talking about having a poker run, where you would fly to different airports to get your hand, then come back here. The chapter is also talking about having a treasure hunt where the pilot takes a non-flying person with them as a camera man to take pictures of certain things at different locations. There would be like a month to get this done, then have a group of people to act as judges to look at everyones pictures. Scott said these are just a few things the EAA Chapter is talking about to keep things going on at the airport.

End of Managers Report

Carol asks Scott how the TAP pilot, (Train a Pilot), was coming along at the Decatur EAA chapter and Scott replied it wasn't moving along like it should be and explained some on it.

Carol also asks Scott what it meant to go SOLO. Scott explained that SOLO means the student is the only one in the airplane and shows the instructor that he or she can take the plane up and do a few landings and takeoffs on their own without the assistance of an instructor, then the instructor can sign them off too SOLO if they can do it his satisfaction.

Old Business

Scott mentions needing to talk to Lindsay Hausman to see if she has found out anything about getting our farm ground back on the west side of runway 18-36. Some discussion ensued on the issue.

New Business

Steve said we only had one engineering firm put their name in to be our consultants and it was Hanson's. Rick made a motion to elect Hanson Professional Services to be our consultants for the next five years. John second it and it was approved by all saying aye.

Scott asks Steve if he had heard anything from Lindsay Hausman on the reskinning of the Main Hangar. Steve said he would have to check with her and get updated before he could really say. Some discussion ensued on the reskinning of the hangar.

Steve said the resurfacing of the ramp will come first because it would be considered a safety issue, then the Main Hangar. Steve also mentioned that airport had \$120,000 in CD's and the ramp would take 5% of that. The reskinning would be 10% to the airport, so we probably wouldn't have enough to due it without taking out a loan. Some discussion ensued.

Paul made a motion to adjourn and John second it.
