DATES PERTAINING TO CANDIDATE FILING FOR THE 2026 GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION:

August 5, 2025	Petition Circulation Begins – candidates may begin circulating petitions on this date.	
October 27 – November 3, 2025	Established Party Nomination Filing – candidates must file their nomination documents during this timeframe.
