**GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION**  
**NOMINATING PETITIONS AVAILABLE**

Jessica Fox, Shelby County Clerk and Recorder wants to notify the public that nominating petitions and other forms for local office candidates will be available for pick-up at the office of Shelby County Clerk and Recorder, located second floor of the courthouse, at 301 East Main Street in Shelbyville beginning Tuesday, September 5, 2023, which is also the first day petitions can be circulated.

Nominating petition packets are for the General Primary Election, which will be held on Tuesday, March 19, 2024. The local candidate offices to be nominated at the General Primary Election are Circuit Clerk, Coroner, States Attorney, County Board Members #1-11 (2-year term), County Board District #4 (Unexpired 2-year term). County Board of Review seats are pending court action. County Board of Review Member-District #1 (Unexpired 4-year term), and County Board of Review Member-District 2 (Full term), providing the Court rules these seats should be elected. The only office to be elected at the General Primary Election is that of Precinct Committeeperson, which is for a 2-year term.

All packets for the above offices can be picked-up during regular office hours, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., except for the observation of holidays on Monday, October 9; Friday, November 10; Thursday, November 23; and Friday, November 24.

The filing period for these offices is November 27 – December 4, 2023. The County Clerk’s office will open at 8:00 a.m. on the first day of filing and on the last day of filing will remain open until 5:00 p.m.
