Changes in the US Postal Service May Affect the way you pay Your Real Estate Taxes

Important Real Estate Tax Payment Due Date Information

Shelby County, IL — The Shelby County Treasurer's Office announces a reminder of the second installment due date for the 2025 Real Estate tax payments. The second installment is due on September 2, 2025.

Payment Options: Residents have several options for paying their taxes:

- USPS Mail: Payments must be postmarked by the due date. To make sure it is
 posted marked in your local post office you will need to have a USPS official hand
 stamp it, or you may be at risk of having an incorrect mark. Depositing your payment
 in the drop box may not be adequate to ensure timely delivery and a proper
 accounting of your payment.
- Banks: Payments are accepted at most banks in Shelby County. Payments can be made at most banks in the county regardless of your affiliation with that bank up to and on the due date.
- In-Person: Payments can be made at the Treasurer's Office in the courthouse. Office hours are 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

Credit card payments are also accepted online at www.govtechtaxpro.com. Please note that a convenience fee will be charged by the credit card company. There is also an option for E-Check with a \$2.00 fee. The on-line option will not be available after the second installment due date of September 2, 2025.

The County Treasurer is responsible for the collection and distribution of these funds. For any inquiries regarding tax rates, levies, and taxes sold at a previous tax sale, please contact the County Clerk at 217-774-4421.
