

### WHAT IS DRUG COURT?

Drug Court is for people who are in the justice system because of substance use. We want to keep you out of jail because we believe you have value and belong in the community. Our goal is to provide you with the treatment, structure, and support you need to change your life.

Drug Court is very different from traditional court because a skilled team works together to provide you with the support you need.

#### **DRUG COURT GOALS**

- Long-lasting sobriety
- Provide structure and support
- Access to resources for jobs, housing, schooling, life skills, and family relationships.



## **HOW IT WORKS?**

Our program is divided into 5 phases. As you progress in treatment, you will move up in phases towards your graduation.

Phase IA Orientation

Phase IB
Phase II
Orientation and Information

Phase III Restructuring
Phase IV Life Skills
